Data Privacy Notice

EFG Bank (Monaco) SAM (hereinafter 'EFG') provides to all individuals who visit its premises (hereinafter 'you') the following information regarding the closed-circuit television (CCTV) systems that operate at their premises.

1. Monitoring and processing your personal data (your image) are carried out for the purpose of preventing and deterring illegal activities and to gather evidence in the event of an offense.
2. The legal basis for processing the data is that it is necessary for the purposes of the prevailing legitimate interests pursued by EFG, as described above
3. Apart from third parties acting on behalf of EFG (e.g., CCTV maintenance or security companies), recipients of your personal data may include judicial, prosecuting and police authorities, as well as the person who is depicted as the victim and/or the perpetrator of the above illegal activities
4. Your personal data will not be transmitted outside of Monaco.
5. The data will be destroyed within a period of up to 30 days, unless their retention is permitted or required under law or regulations
6. If you wish to exercise your right of access to, rectification, deletion, restriction or objection to the processing of your personal data, contact our Data Protection Officer at dpo-monaco@efgbank.com, or send a letter to the address mentioned above
