

PRIVACY NOTICE REGARDING THE CLOSED-CIRCUIT TELEVISION (CCTV) SYSTEM

EFG Wealth Management (Israel) Ltd (“EFG”) provides the following information regarding the closed-circuit television (CCTV) systems that operate at its premises in accordance with the applicable Israeli Privacy Regulations:

1. EFG collects personal data about visitors to its premises through its closed-circuit television (CCTV) system, including visual recordings (image/video) and related metadata (such as the date, time and location of the recording). Such personal data is processed for the purpose of security and safety, including the protection of persons, property, and the premises, as well as preventing and deterring illegal activities.
2. **By visiting our premises, you acknowledge and agree that the Company uses a CCTV system and may collect and use information about you, as described in this Privacy Policy.**
3. Access to and disclosure of your personal data will be limited to authorized personnel on behalf of EFG, and only to the extent necessary to achieve the purposes of processing. Notwithstanding the foregoing, EFG may disclose personal data as required or permitted by applicable law, including in response to a request, order or instruction from a competent authority (including a court, law enforcement authority, or regulatory authority). In all cases, EFG will use its best reasonable efforts to protect your privacy and maintain the confidentiality of your personal data in accordance with applicable law.
4. Your personal data will not be transmitted outside Israel.
5. The data will be retained for a period of up to 30 days, unless their retention is permitted or required under applicable law or is necessary for handling an incident, investigation, legal proceedings
